

1. The Website does not automatically collect any information, except for information contained in cookies.
2. Cookies are IT data, in particular text files, which are stored in the Website User's end device and are intended for using the Website's pages. Cookies usually contain the name of the web page from which they come, the period of their storage in the end device, as well as their unique number.
3. The entity placing cookies on the Website User's end device and accessing them is the Website operator.
4. Cookies are used for the following purposes:
  - a. adapting the content of the Website pages to the User's preferences and optimising the use of the web pages; in particular, these files allow to recognise the Website User's device and to properly display the web page, tailored to their individual needs;
  - b. creating statistics that help to understand how Website Users use web pages, which allows improving their structure and content;
  - c. maintaining the Website User's session (after logging in), thanks to which the User does not have to re-enter the login and password on each page of the Website;
5. As part of the Website, two basic types of cookies are used: "session" cookies and "persistent" cookies. Session cookies are temporary files which are stored on the User's end device until logging out, leaving the web page or closing the software (web browser). Persistent cookies are stored on the User's end device for the time specified in the cookie file parameters or until they are deleted by the User.
6. The following types of cookies are used on the Website:
  - a. "necessary" cookies, enabling the use of services available on the Website, e.g. authentication cookies used for services requiring authentication on the Website;
  - b. cookies used to ensure security, e.g. used to detect fraud in the field of authentication within the Website;
  - c. "performance" cookies, enabling the collection of information on how the Website's pages are used;
  - d. "functional" cookies, enabling "remembering" the settings selected by the User and personalising the User's interface, e.g. in terms of the selected language or region from which the User comes from, font size, web page appearance, etc.;
7. In many cases, the software used for browsing web pages (web browser) allows cookies to be stored on the User's end device by default. Website users may change their cookie settings at any time. These settings can be changed, in particular, in such a way as to block the automatic handling of cookies in the web browser settings or to provide the information about each time they are placed on the Website User's device. Detailed information regarding options and methods of handling cookies is available in the software settings (web browser).
8. The Website Operator informs you that restrictions on the use of cookies may affect some of the functionalities available on the Website's pages.
9. Cookies placed on the Website User's end device may also be used by advertisers and partners cooperating with the Website operator.
