INFORMATION ON VIDEO SURVEILLANCE AT PLATINUM MOUNTAIN HOTEL & SPA AND PLATINUM APARTMENTS

Personal Data Administrator:

The Administrator uses surveillance cameras which record the image around the clock within the range of the cameras. Monitoring can record the image of people who are in the monitored area. Monitoring cameras are installed in marked rooms and public areas inside and outside the buildings of Platinum Mountain Hotel & SPA and Platinum Apartments. The areas covered by the cameras' coverage are marked with the inscription "Monitored object" or a similar one along with a graphic sign.

The purpose of the monitoring is to ensure safety, protect property and the ability to defend or pursue claims, which constitutes the legitimate interest of the Administrator (Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR). The image from the cameras can be observed live and stored for a period not longer than 3 months from the date of recording. Recordings are automatically overwritten on this date at the latest, however, the overwriting may occur earlier, depending on the intensity of traffic within the range of the cameras. In the event that the monitoring recordings constitute evidence in legal proceedings or may constitute evidence in such proceedings, the monitoring recordings will be kept until the final conclusion of the proceedings.

The monitoring record may be disclosed to the entities which provide the Administrator with services aimed at the protection of persons and property, IT or legal services, for the purposes related to the nature of the services provided by these entities. In addition, the monitoring record may be provided to the authorized bodies, if required by the generally applicable law, in particular for the purposes of conducted proceedings.

The persons whose image was registered while staying in the monitored area have the right to request access to personal data, their rectification, deletion or restriction of processing.

The persons whose image was registered while staying in the area subject to monitoring have the right to object – for the reasons related to their particular situation – to the processing of personal data obtained through monitoring. In the event of an objection, the Administrator will cease processing the image of these persons, unless there are valid legitimate grounds for processing, overriding the interests of these persons, rights and freedoms, or if there are grounds for establishing, investigating or defending claims.

The persons whose image was registered while staying in the monitored area also have the right to file a complaint with the supervisory body.
