

OUTDOOR SWIMMING POOL REGULATIONS

- 1. The outdoor swimming pool (hereinafter referred to as the "Pool") is a facility which can be used only by the guests (hereinafter referred to as the "Guests") registered at the Platinum Mountain Hotel & SPA.
- 2. The Pool can be used only when the white flag is displayed and the lifeguard is present at the stand.
- 3. No flag or a red flag displayed means that it is strictly forbidden to use the Pool and enter the water.
- 4. The Hotel may close the Pool due to weather conditions.
- 5. The Pool may be used by the Guests of the Platinum Mountain Hotel & Spa and the persons designated by the Hotel.
- 6. The Guests use the Pool free of charge.
- 7. Children up to the age of 12 may stay in the area of the Pool and/or use the Pool only under the supervision of adults.

8. People using the Pool are forbidden to:

- a) enter the Pool area wearing footwear other than that intended for use in the area of the Pool,
- b) jump into the Pool from the shore or other place,
- c) do scuba diving,
- d) sit and lean on the edge of the Pool,
- e) damage the Pool facilities and equipment, litter and foul up the Pool as well as the area around the Pool.
- f) enter the Pool against the prohibition or when the Pool is not provided for use,
- g) use the Pool in the hours other than between 10:00 and 20:00,
- h) bring animals to the Pool area and/or bring animals into the Pool,
- i) bring and/or consume alcohol/alcoholic beverages in the Pool and in the Pool area,
- j) eat and drink in the Pool,
- k) bring glass, glassware, sharp objects and other dangerous objects into the Pool,
- l) behave indecently and/or in a manner inconsistent with the principles of social coexistence and/or in a way that hinders using the Pool by other Guests,
- m) use the Pool in a manner inconsistent with the provisions of the hereby regulations.
- 9. The Hotel may impose a fine of up to PLN 500 for breaking the above regulations.
- 10. It is forbidden to enter the Pool and the area of the Pool if drunk or under the influence of alcohol.
- 11. Only the persons wearing swimming trunks and/or bathing suits may use the Pool.
- 12. Children under 3 years of age using the swimming pool must wear disposable diapers or reusable diapers.
 - a) If there is a leak from the diapers, which causes contamination of the swimming pool area, the hotel has the right to impose a fee of PLN 2,500.00 gross on the guest.
- 13. Entering the Pool is possible only after using the shower located by the Pool.
- 14. The persons using the Pool are obliged to strictly follow the instructions of the lifeguards.
- 15. The Pool is guarded by a lifeguard, however, the Pool can only be used by the persons who can swim, whereas those who cannot swim can use the Pool only under the supervision of the persons who can swim.





- 16. The persons violating public order, the provisions of the hereby regulations, committing an offense and/or a crime may be forcibly removed from the Pool area by the Hotel staff.
- 17. The persons vandalising or damaging the facilities and equipment of the Pool are liable for damages under the general principles set out in the Civil Code.
- 18. All complaints, comments and requests regarding the functioning of the Pool should be reported to the Hotel Front Office.
- 19. These regulations are available in a visible place on the board next to the Outdoor Swimming Pool.
- 20. In matters not covered by the regulations, the provisions of generally applicable law shall apply, including primarily the provisions of the Civil Code.
- 21. Any disputes may be resolved by a common court of law based on general principles.
