Caracara Reserve Sauvignon Blanc

Central Valley | Chile

Fresh and fruity, well balanced acidity and a pleasant finish.

Veneto | Italy

Succulent and fruity with a hint of lemon and an elegant dry finish.

Michelsberg | Germany

Soft medium sweet wine with a good balance and soft fruity finish.

Mr Goose Chardonnay

South East | Australia

Aromas of candied lemon, lime and honeydew melon. The palate is a fusion of sweetcitrus, pear drop and ripe melon flavours.

Alasia Cortese

Piemonte | Italy

Gentle and fragrant with notes of grapefruit, lime and honeysuckle. The palate is lightly honeyed, yet fresh and crisp with bright lemony fruit and a twist of minerality on the finish.

Western Cape | South Africa

A delicious, crisp, fresh wine with an array of tropical fruit flavours.

Brampton Unoaked Chardonnay

Stellenbosch | South Africa

Sublte dry white wine with all the ripe fruit of a top Chardonnay, but without the oak flavours

Allan Scott Estate Sauvignon Blanc

Marlborough | New Zealand

A fragrant mix of pineapple and passion fruit tropical flavours withunderlying zesty citrus characters of orange and lime.

Domaine Bieville Chablis

Burgundy | France

30 year old vines producing smoky lime aromas and flavours; bone dry, minerally but supple and moreish with a long, creamy finish.

Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc

Marlborough | New Zealand

Characteristically uplifting aromas of ripe lime and grapefruit, nectarine, papaya and mango.

Sol Del Oro Rosé

Central Valley | Chile

Ripe and plummy, well balanced and brimming with dark fruits.

Buffalo Ridge Zinfandel Rosé

California | USA

Refreshing and easy drinking with sweetness and a hint of ripe red fruits.

Light and refreshing with gentle hints of summer fruit and a long dry finish.

Whispering Angel Rosé

Provence | France

Aromas of spicy notes with a palate of blackcurrants, wild strawberries and Peach Melba, with citrus notes at the finish.

Caracara Reserve Merlot

Central Valley | Chile

Bright ruby-red, this unoaked Merlot shows black and red cherry, spicy plum and blackcurrant all wrapped up in the velvety textured palate.

Alto de Mayo Malbec

Mendoza | Argentina

Damson, blackberry and plum flavours, accented by touches of oak toast. Smooth, ripe tannins for a silky finish.

Mr Goose Shiraz

South East | Australia

The palate is concentrated showing blackberry, black cherry and plum flavours. Complex oak characters of coffee, vanilla and caramel on the finish.

Central Valley | Chile

Smooth with ripe berry and black bramble and balanced tannins.

Primitivo Rosso IGT Caleo

Puglia | Italy

A dark, ruby red with violet highlights. Intense and fragrant bouquet of dates and red fruit. Beautifully smooth on the palate.

Letargo Rioja Crianza Bodegas D. Mateos

Rioja | Spain

Full and rich, with a marked acidity, notes of Prunes and aromas of toasted bread and vanilla.

Tempus Two Silver Series Merlot

South East | Australia

A rich, soft smooth wine with plum fruit on the nose and a palate packed with ripe raspberry notes finishing with subtle hints of oak.

Chianti D.O.C.G Castelsina

Tuscany | Italy

Earthy, dark fruit aromas, piquant sour cherry freshness and subtle leathery spice on the finish.

Holmes Point Pinot Noir

Marlborough | New Zealand

Powerful and jammy with refreshing acidity the palate is redolent of raspberries, strawberries, cherries, watermelon and blackberries laced with vanilla.

Altano Douro Red Organic

Douro | Portugal

Deep in colour and part matured in oak, ripe and spicy as would be expected from the rich Portgrape varieties used.

El Meson Rioja Reserva

Rioja | Spain

A deep cherry colour with complex aromas. This is a pure and versatile wine with rich black fruit underpinned by subtle vanilla oak.

Le Moulin Rose de Malescasse, Chateau Malascasse, Haut-Medoc

Bordeaux | France

Well-ripened forest fruits complemented by a supple, rounded and silky palate with an integrated oak finish.

Scott Base Pinot Noir

Central Otago | New Zealand

Showing ripe plum, cherry fruit, dried herbs and spice characters along with impressive weight and concentration.

Chateauneuf du Pape ‘Tradition’ Berthet Rayne

Rhone | France

Full-bodied and powerful in style with juicy berry fruit flavours dominant on the palate. Ground pepper notes and firm tannins provide structure and complexity.

Great aromatic intensity, with stone fruit and floral hints a long sweet finish.

Prosecco Spumante Vispo Allegro

Veneto | Italy

Delicately fruity, slightly aromatic bouquet with hints of flowers and honey.

Lunetta Prosecco Rosé Spumante

Veneto | Italy

Fresh berry aromas and a fine mousse lead to redcurrant and citrus notes on the palate, balanced by bright acidity and a clean, dry finish.

Midas Prosecco Extra Dry DOC

Veneto | Italy

Fresh, pleasantly lively, its imprint lingers for a long time on the palate.

CHAMPAGNE

Môet & Chandon Brut Impérial

Champagne | France

A perfect balance of citrus fruit aromas and brioche. Subtle style with a crisp and lively palate.

Champagne | France

A lovely biscuity, appley nose gives out to generous fruit overlaid with a yeasty tastiness.

Champagne | France

Pale salmon in colour and aromas of strawberries, redcurrants, raspberries and blackcherries. The benchmark of Rosé Champagne.

Dom Pérignon Brut

Champagne | France

Dom Pérignon, named after the cellar master who perfected the sparkling wine-making process that createdchampagne in the 1600’s At the very top of the prestige Champagne rankings.
